THE FACULTY MACE

Dr. Théodore Arcand, '57 (Hons.. B.A. in History), '95 (LL.D), designed and commissioned an academic mace for the Faculty of Humanities in memory of his wife, Jennifer '57 (Hons.. B.A. in English). Made of solid silver and plated with gold, the Mace was crafted by Quebec artisan, Marker Markarian.

Ceremonial maces in university faculties have been used since the 13th century. Examples of maces in arts faculties include the universities of Vienna, Heidelberg, Prague, Saint Andrews, Paris, Padua and many others. The McMaster Humanities Mace is, we believe, the first such object in Canada, allowing it to be another appropriate emblem of the country's most innovative university. The Faculty Mace is used in appropriate Faculty ceremonials and processions. The Mace is carried by a Faculty Bedel or, in his or her absence, the Pro-Bedel. The Bedel and Pro-Bedel are the longest and the second-longest serving members of the Faculty.

The Faculty Mace is rich in symbolism and incorporates a number of pieces of Jennifer Arcand's jewellery. It consists of three parts, the first being a pine cone filial which surmounts a crown-like form made up of six bands of acanthus leaves. This form encloses a central stem bearing a silver-gilt hat pin of Austro-Hungarian origin, decorated with three small rubies and an emerald, depicting a pelican slashing its breast to feed its young, a symbol of sacrifice. On a triangular gold mount there are fixed three pins of Hungarian origin. The first is partly enamelled in white and red and on a cross-like form holds a green stone engraved with a male arm bearing a sword. At each of the extremities of the cross, there is mounted a garnet. In addition, there are three larger garnet pendants. The second pin is an enamel depicting Saint George slaving the dragon. At each of the extremities of the cross, there is mounted a pearl. In addition, there are three pearl pendants on the lower part of the pin. The third pin is richly enamelled in blue, white and green. A blue enamelled panel surrounded by a white arch bears a small diamond set in a triangular gold setting (the eye of God). At either side, there are female supporters and, at the base, a putto. The top of the arch is embellished by a small emerald, and the bottom, by two small garnets, two pearls and a faceted crystal. The first point of the triangular framework bears an Indian diamond ring (eight small diamonds around a small emerald, surrounded by an oval gold setting). The next point bears an oval amethyst pin set within a band of ten Ceylon pearls. The third point bears a second century Roman onyx seal, engraved with the figure of Pallas Athene wearing a helmet and bearing a spear and shield.

The next portion of the Mace consists of six oval laurel crowns set on a circle, which in turn bears six intertwined bands of olive leaves. In between each of these bands is set a coat of arms. They are as follows: Canada, the City of Hamilton, the Arcand coat of arms, the Province of Ontario, McMaster University, the Arcand Bassi-Sertorio arms.

The third portion of the Mace consists of a solid silver column embellished by a spiralling band of acanthus leaves. In between the band, the following text is engraved: "In loving memory of Jennifer Marjorie Arcand from her husband, Théodore Arcand, her son Jean-Louis Arcand and daughter-in-law, Francesca Bassi Arcand, October 1997".
